



Research or Development of Classroom Materials Award



This award is designed to provide financial support for library materials, field research or the preparation of pedagogical activities.



Annual Due Date: October 15th

Eligible Applicants: Any NNETESOL member

Grant Amount: Up to \$500 per year for one applicant

Criteria: Applications are evaluated on the research/development's practical feasibility; relevance to the classroom; soundness of rationale and theoretical basis; clarity of indicated language level and intended student population; organization; and expression. The research or development must be completed within a calendar year of the due date. The recipient of the award will also present the results of the research/development at a NNETESOL conference and contribute documentation to the NNETESOL archives.

1. Personal contact information – name, mailing address, home telephone number, and email address
2. School contact information (which you are employed or affiliated with) – name, mailing address, and work telephone number
3. Resume, which should include your background in English as a Second Language (ESL)
4. Summarize your research/development – rationale; pedagogical purpose and procedure; and expected contribution to the ESL professional field and contribution to local teachers (300 word maximum)
5. A detailed budget of your estimated financial costs
6. Provide a start date for research/development and target date for completion
7. Explain how you plan to share the results of this project/research or how materials will be distributed for interested teachers
